As we begin, consider these points about playing games:

- Think ahead about what will happen in a game.
- Make sure the game is teaching or reinforcing a lesson.
- Be sure the rules are well defined.
- Be sure the game is played fairly!
- If it has pieces, be sure all the pieces are present and working.
- Consider the age of the children.
- If you only have one student, he can go backward or lose a point for a wrong answer since there's no one else to take their turn. And remember, doing better than you did last time is another way to win – it doesn't have to be about beating someone else!

Calling out the books of the New Testament and ask which is first

1-2-3-4 you call out any three books of the Bible in a row and the student has to say the 4th

Popsicle sticks

Clothespins for books of the Bible

Recite one book at a time

Recite books backwards

Sword Drills and alternate - call out a New Testament scripture such as John 3:16; the first person finds the book of John then passes the Bible; the second person finds chapter 3 and passes the Bible; the third person finds verse 14 and passes the Bible; the next person reads the scripture; then the Bible is passed to the next person and you start again
